Conference

It features keynote speeches, panel discussions, and workshops that explore cutting-edge ideas to transform education. For example, stakeholders discuss strategies for equipping Indian students with future-forward skills, aligning with national priorities like NEP 2020 to ensure quality education and holistic development

Discussions cover a range of topics – from integrating emerging technologies (AI, digital tools) into pedagogy, to reshaping curricula for critical thinking and vocational training. By bringing together thought leaders in education, the conference sheds light on improvements needed in the education system and shares best practices to empower students with the pertinent skills and knowledge to succeed in an evolving world

This participation track is ideal for attendees looking to learn from experts, contribute ideas, and collaborate on fostering an education ecosystem that nurtures innovation, skill acquisition, and lifelong learning.

Expo

The Expo is an interactive exhibition that runs alongside the conference, offering attendees a hands-on look at the I atest innovations in the education sector. Exhibitors include ed-tech companies, curriculum developers, skill training programs, government education departments, and schools showcasing successful projects. This is a distinct opportunity for participants to discover new tools, products, and methodologies that can enhance teaching and learning.

These exhibits allow teachers and institutional leaders to experience emerging solutions that make education more engaging and effective.

 Networking and Collaboration: The environment encourages networking among educators, policymakers, and industry leaders



Attendees can interact directly with product developers, ask questions, and even participate in live demos or trials of educational products. This fosters collaboration – for example, a school leader might partner with a tech provider to pilot a new skill-learning app, or a state education officer might connect with NGOs about implementing a successful career guidance program in government schools.

Skill Development Focus:

Many exhibits specifically address skill development themes – such as robotics and coding workshops for K-12, career counseling tools, or vocational training modules. Given the conclave's theme, the expo highlights solutions that help students learn by doing and acquire practical competencies. Some stalls may showcase student projects or outcomes (e.g. models built by students as part of an innovation challenge), underlining how these tools translate to real skills.

This gala event shines a spotlight on the schools, individuals, and government initiatives that have set benchmarks in innovation and quality, especially in promoting skill-based education. It is a distinct participation opportunity wherein nominees, honorees, and other attendees come together to honor the achievements of their peers

• Celebration of Excellence: The ceremony honors top performers in various categories, highlighting excellence and innovation in education

.From the best-performing schools to visionary educators and impactful government programs (detailed in the categories above), award winners are announced and invited on stage to receive trophies or plaques. Each award is presented by eminent dignitaries – for instance, educational leaders or government officials – adding prestige to the recognition. The atmosphere is one of celebration and inspiration, as success stories are shared with the a audience.

• Recognition & Inspiration: By recognising the achievements of individuals and institutions that have made significant contributions, the awards aim to inspire others to strive for excellence

Short citations or videos often highlight why each winner was selected – such as a brief overview of a school's innovative program or a teacher's exceptional work – allowing all attendees to learn from these exemplars. The narrative of each award emphasizes how innovative practices or dedicated leadership led to improved outcomes, reinforcing the conclave's message that focusing on skills and innovation yields tangible benefits in education.

Distinct Opportunity: For participants, attending the awards night is an opportunity to
network in a celebratory setting. Educators and officials from across India mingle, which
can spark new collaborations or mentorship. It's also a moment for the education
community to collectively acknowledge progress: as the Union Education Minister noted
in a similar conclave, such events shed light on improvements in the quality of education
and underscore the collective aim to prepare students with necessary skills for the future

The awards ceremony thus not only rewards excellence but also galvanizes the community around shared goals.



School Awards – Categories & Criteria



This segment honors schools (primarily K-12 institutions) that exemplify excellence in various aspects of education. Key award categories and their criteria include:

 Innovation in School Education: Recognizes schools pioneering creative teaching methodologies and experiential learning programs that enhance student engagement and learning outcomes

Criteria: Use of new instructional approaches (e.g. technology integration, project-based learning) that drive academic excellence and skill development among students. Evaluation looks at curriculum design and teaching practices that prepare students for future success

 Excellence in Curriculum Development: Celebrates outstanding efforts to design and enrich school curricula with innovative content and pedagogical improvements

Criteria: Alignment of the curriculum with evolving educational needs and 21st-century skills, inclusion of interdisciplinary or skill-based modules, and creation of engaging learning experiences. Judges consider how the curriculum changes empower students with a more effective and holistic learning experience.

 Outstanding Student Engagement Initiative: Honors exceptional programs that significantly boost student involvement, motivation, and holistic development

Criteria: The initiative should foster students' academic and personal growth through active engagement inside and beyond the classroom. Examples include interactive learning projects, clubs or competitions, and co-curricular activities that build skills and enthusiasm for learning.

Impact is measured in terms of improved student participation, collaboration, and skill gains (communication, critical thinking, etc.).



Individual Awards – Categories & Criteria



These awards recognize exemplary contributions by individuals in the education sector – from teachers on the frontlines to visionary leaders shaping policy. Major categories include:

 Outstanding Educator (Teacher) Award: Celebrates a teacher who has demonstrated teaching excellence by inspiring students and improving learning outcomes through innovative techniques. Criteria: Evidence of creative pedagogy and dedication to student success, such as integrating new technologies or methodologies to enhance learning. For instance, leveraging "pedagogy innovations" and continually improving curriculum design are qualities highlighted for such educators.

Their work should have led to better student performance or engagement in the classroom.

 Outstanding School Principal Award: Recognizes a school principal who has shown isionary leadership and innovation in running a school

Criteria: Transformational leadership that positively impacts the school's academic standards, student achievements, teacher development, and overall school growth

Such principals are often noted for fostering a positive school culture, implementing progressive policies (aligned with NEP 2020 goals), and driving initiatives that improve both teaching quality and skill-oriented learning for students.

• Education Thought Leader Award: Honors an individual (educator, policymaker, or academic) whose ideas and advocacy have significantly advanced the field of education. Criteria: A sustained body of work that has had a broad impact on educational practices or policy. The recipient is typically known for thought leadership – for example, contributing research, thought-provoking publications, or influential programs that promote educational innovation. They have a reputation for shaping discourse in education and inspiring improvements (such as championing skill development programs, curriculum reforms, or inclusive education policies). In essence, this awardee's contributions "significantly impact and advance the field" of education, aligning with the conclave's mission to push forward new ideas in skill-based education.



Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan Government Awards – Categories & Criteria



Named after the Government of India's integrated school education scheme, these awards applaud government bodies (state or district education departments, and related public institutions) for outstanding initiatives, policies, or program implementation in school education. The focus is on how effectively government efforts are improving educational quality and promoting skill development at scale. Key award categories include:

A national leader presents an education award to a government education officer, exemplifying successful public-sector initiatives being recognized. Bes

State Implementation of Education Reforms: Highlights a state or union territory for exemplary execution of education programs under national policies (such as Samagra Shiksha or NEP 2020 reforms). Criteria: Measurable improvements and outcomes as a result of government initiatives – for example, increases in student enrollment/retention, enhanced infrastructure and resources, teacher training upgrades, or notable progress in inclusive education. (Notably, Andhra Pradesh was recently lauded as the "Best State in implementing" inclusive education mandates for students with disabilities, illustrating the kind of achievement this category rewards.) States that effectively implement central schemes – aligning with objectives like universal access, equity, and quality in schooling – would be strong contenders.

Innovative Education Policy or Initiative Award: Recognizes a government-led policy, program, or project that introduced an innovative solution to educational challenges. Criteria: The initiative should demonstrate creativity in design or execution and show significant impact on learning outcomes or skill development. This could include pioneering policies for vocational education in schools, digital learning initiatives, or community-driven education programs. Alignment with National Education Policy 2020 recommendations (such as competency-based learning, multilingual education, or curriculum reforms) is considered a plus

The jury looks for evidence that the policy/initiative has improved the education system in a tangible way – for instance, a successful new skills training program for secondary students or a public-private partnership enhancing STEM education in government schools.

Outstanding Government Initiative for Skill Development: Awards a specific government program or scheme that has effectively equipped students with vocational or 21st-century skills. Criteria: The initiative should focus on practical skill training, entrepreneurship, or vocational education within the school curriculum, and show results in terms of student skill acquisition or employability. Under Samagra Shiksha, promoting vocational education and skill training is a key component of improving quality

An example might be a state's rollout of a robust vocational curriculum in high schools or a skill competition program that scaled nationally. The award evaluates how well the program is integrated into the education system, the breadth of student participation, and outcomes like certifications earned or students transitioning to skilled jobs or further skill education. In essence, this category highlights government efforts that prepare youth with practical skills, aligning directly with the conclave's skill development theme.

Best Implementation of Digital Education Initiatives

Recognizes efforts to integrate digital tools and e-learning platforms into government schools to enhance learning experiences and bridge the digital divide.

Best Inclusive Education Initiative

Honors initiatives that successfully promote inclusion, ensuring quality education for children with disabilities or special needs through adaptive teaching and infrastructure improvements.

Excellence in Vocational Skill Development

Rewards programs that effectively incorporate vocational training and skill development within the school curriculum, preparing students for future employment and entrepreneurial opportunities..

Best Teacher Training & Capacity Building Program

Celebrates initiatives aimed at strengthening the quality of education by providing innovative and effective training programs that empower teachers with modern pedagogical skills.

Best Community Engagement Initiative

Acknowledges efforts that involve parents and local communities in the educational process, enhancing student learning outcomes and fostering a supportive environment for schools.

Best Infrastructure & Learning Environment Enhancement

Recognizes projects that have significantly improved physical infrastructure or the overall learning environment in schools, including the adoption of technology and modern learning aids.
